Pickleball is a paddleball sport that combines elements of tennis, badminton, and table tennis. Two or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a Wiffle Ball, over a net. The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules somewhat similar to tennis, with several modifications. Pickleball was invented in the mid 1960s as a children's backyard game

Wikipedia notes that "...Some sources claim the name "Pickleball" was derived from that of the family dog, Pickles, others claim the name came from the term "pickle boat".

Regardless of the sport's origin, it is becoming quite popular amongst young and old.

A few words from Linden Woods Community Foundation

Since registration as a charity in 1992, the Linden Woods Community Foundation has enjoyed tremendous support from the community. Over \$400,000 has been raised by various fundraising activities, capital campaigns, and matching grant applications. As a result, the Foundation was able to contribute \$385,000 to the community centre for various capital projects, equipment purchases, and program support.

Our most recent project, the establishment of scholarships at the Universities of Manitoba and Winnipeg, has also enjoyed broad community support.
